Carlisle ranks third in nation

Miami-based Carlisle Development Group was the nation's third ranked affordable housing developer in 2010, according to a housing trade publication.

Affordable Housing Finance released its list of Top 50 Affordable Housing Developers this month, ranking Carlisle behind The Michaels Organization in New Jersey and The NRP Group in Ohio.

Carlisle started 18 different projects last year, and is currently developing the 90-unit Beacon in Overtown and the 467-unit mixed used Brownsville Transit Center, both in Miami.

Miami's Pinnacle Housing Group was ranked 7th, and Miami's Biscayne Housing Group was ranked 12th. Rural Neighbors, Inc., in Florida City, was ranked 29.
